

A. FAMILIES FOR LIFE@COMMUNITY (FFLC)

FFLC strengthens family ties and resilience, through bringing Family Life Education into community spaces. It aims to bring community-based ecosystem of support for families across life stages. As a regional anchor SSA, Fei Yue FFLC delivers evidence-based Marriage and Parenting programmes, coordinates efforts across community partners for a more concerted effort to support families; and refers families requiring more support to FSCs, SSOs and specialist centres.

1. PARENTING

Parenting Support Services aims to strengthen parent-child relationships, reduce difficult behaviours among their children and equip parents with knowledge, skills and confidence through the delivery of Positive Parenting Programme¹ ("Triple P") and Signposts².

Services Include

- a) Webinars/ Seminars
- b) One to One consultation with a parenting coach
- c) Group work with a small group of parents
- d) Signpost Group Work for parents with children with special educational needs

¹ Triple P is a parenting and family support programme to prevent children's behavioural and emotional problems. Parents who used Triple P strategies have reported reduced parenting stress and reduced child behavioural problems.

² Signposts is a programme designed to help parents understand and manage their children's difficult behaviours and to prevent further development of behavioural concerns.



B. FAM@FSC (FEI YUE - CHOA CHU KANG)

FAM@FSC (Fei Yue – Choa Chu Kang) provides a range of support for families who encounter some challenges in their marriage, parenting and divorce issues. Families can approach FAM@FSC for transnational and early marriage preparation, parenting, and divorce workshops to gain knowledge and skills to build strong family relationships. For those who need more help, there is also counselling support. Referrals are welcomed.

1. MARRIAGE

It provides marital support services for transnational couples (Singaporeans marrying a non-residential/foreigner) and young couples (either partner is below 21 years or grooms aged 21-24 years). It works together with community partners and volunteers to serve these couples through provision of marital preparation programmes, workshops and social activities to build social support for the couples.

2. YOUTH GO!

Youth GO! Programme (YGP) is a street outreach programme funded by Central Youth Guidance Office (CYGO). The key objectives of Youth GO! are to support at-risk youth so that they will be meaningfully engaged either in their studies or work, stay crime-free and able to solve problems and be resilient individuals.

YGP serves youths 12-21 years old who are:

- a) Out-of-school youths (OSYs) and not engaged in meaningful work.
- b) School students with high absenteeism and/or youths who opted or dropped out of the ESU; or
- c) Youths who have completed the Guidance Programme (GP), Enhanced Step Up (ESU), Streetwise Programme (SWP) and Probation, but require further support upon completion of the programme.
